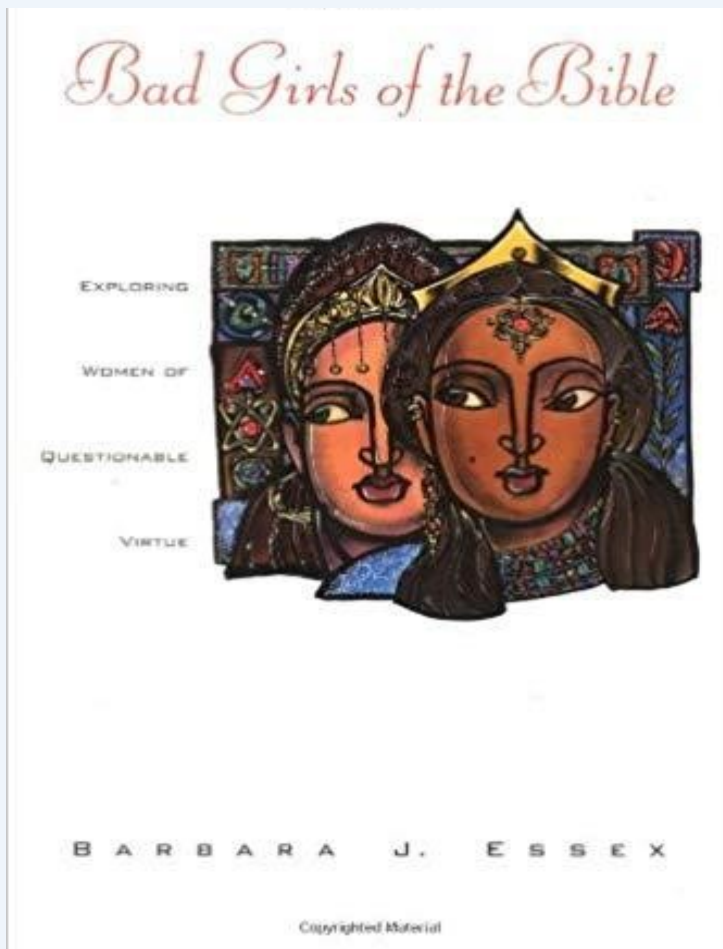


# REDEEMER E-BLAST
