For the rest of the season of Epiphany for our Sunday worship, we will be trying a **new to us liturgy** from *Enriching Our Worship 1*. It was approved for use in 1998 and features more modern language, with contemporary images and metaphors. The service will be familiar, but just enough different that you will need to pay attention, particularly for the Nicene Creed and the Lord's Prayer. The translation of the Lord's Prayer is what the World Council of Churches considers to be the closest translation to the original Greek. We will return to the Book of Common Prayer on Ash Wednesday, in late February. Your feedback welcome and encouraged!
