Looking ahead to Holy Week: Palm Sunday at 11 come to Eucharist in our parking lot! You can listen to the service on your car radio at 93.3 on your FM dial! At the end of the service, the altar party will provide you with a squirt of hand sanitizer, a Palm and the consecrated bread. **Maundy Thursday** occurs virtually at **7:00 PM** at St. John Lutheran Church. **Good Friday** offers two choices: at **noon** join Melinda+ at Epiphany School's Stations of the Cross. You may park on the street or in her driveway. At **7:00 PM** worship virtually here at Redeemer. **Easter Sunday** come Holy Eucharist in the parking lot from the comfort of your car and tune into 93.3 on the FM dial. Like Palm Sunday, the altar party will come out with hand sanitizer and the consecrate bread. You are also welcome to bring your tablet and watch the service as well.

WOMEN'S HISTORY MONTH



Frances Perkins

Frances Perkins was the first woman to serve a President of the United States as a member of the cabinet. Born in Boston in 1880 and educated at Mount Holyoke College and Columbia University, Perkins was passionate about the social problems occasioned by the continuing effects of industrialization and urbanization. As a young adult she discovered the Episcopal Church and was confirmed at the Church of the Holy Spirit in Lake Forest, Illinois, on June 11, 1905, and was a faithful and active Episcopalian for the remainder of her life.


President Roosevelt appointed her to a cabinet post as Secretary of Labor, a position she would hold for twelve years. As Secretary of Labor, Perkins would have a major role in shaping the “New Deal” legislation signed into law by President Roosevelt and which had great impact upon the nation as it emerged from the Great Depression of the early 1930’s.

During her years of public service, Frances Perkins depended upon her faith, her life of prayer, and the guidance of her church for the support she needed to assist the United States and its leadership to face the enormous problems of the time. During her time as Secretary of Labor, she would take time away from her duties on a monthly basis and make a retreat with the All Saints’ Sisters of the Poor in nearby Catonsville, Maryland. Following her public service she became a professor of industrial and labor relations at Cornell University. She remained active in teaching, social justice advocacy, and in the mission of the Episcopal Church until her death in 1965. -Source: *Holy Women Holy Men*
