Stained Glass Windows Return!



Late last week, our stained glass windows returned! They are in the process of being reinstalled and what a difference—they are lovely and look brand new. The majority of our windows are being worked on in place and most will be worked on from the outside of the building. The Te Deum windows (pictured above) will have to be reinstalled inside and require scaffolding to be installed. This latest phase of the project is expected to last from two to four weeks. While the church will be carefully cleaned during installation, please do watch your step while in the Nave.

We anticipate rolling out our Capital Campaign in August and will have information on adopting a window, if that might be your desire.






