# Senior Warden's Report:

- No new information regarding the easement with our neighbor. It is in the hands of the Diocese

#### Junior Warden's Report:

- All 3 boilers are in operation & there are no issues or alarms to report
- The ADA toilet project is complete with one toilet converted in the ladies room in the atrium & one converted in the parish hall. One toilet in the atrium men's room is also completed. Cost \$311.00
- A flapper valve was replaced in the ladies room in the parish hall & the stall door
  was removed & replaced with a shower curtain (thank you Pastor Melinda). This
  will be designated a unisex restroom to have ADA compliance on the lower level
- An oak piece was made & installed in the pulpit to improve audio & visual
- Jeff has contacted his alma mater concerning a skilled brick mason to make repairs. There is not a graduate mason within a 75 mile radius of Sayre. Jeff will continue his search as has another contact
- The outdoor light on the parlor steps needs replacement. This is to be installed next week

- The outdoor lights facing our sign need to be replaced. Jeff plans to mount these lights on the sign posts to aid in lawn mowing
- John Paul has done some work in the tower replaced bulbs for the clock & greased the bells & clock. There is a tear in the screens on the bell level this will be repaired soon
- The AED (defibrillator) battery was replaced; however still not working. To be returned for replacement
