Minutes: Motion to accept the October 14, 2025 minutes made by Bruce, seconded by Alice. Correction to Rector's Report: Regarding the Bixby Trust – in accordance with the terms of the will, that individual's portion is redistributed to the Charitable Trust (not to the other heirs). Motion approved with this correction.

Old Business:

- Our application for a Mission Resources Grant for funding through the diocesan to install new A/V equipment was approved. We received our full ask of \$24,240.00. The new system could potentially be installed by Christmas.
- An Organ/Harp Holiday Concert is scheduled for Sunday, December 14, 2025 at 3:00 PM at Redeemer. Just an FYI, the Valley Chorus Concert is on Sunday, December 7, 2025.

New Business:

- The 2026 Budget was presented by Bruce. Review closely as this is the first draft and if any questions, ask Bruce.
- The Tribute Quartet Concert is scheduled for April 17, 2026 at Redeemer. Although it is not noted on their tour schedule yet, our deposit has cleared the bank.
- We have a potential candidate for an Assistant Priest and is being sent a proposal. Consider adding a line item in the 2026 Budget for a possible hire.
- By-laws of the Church of the Redeemer reviewed and will adopt at the December meeting and present at the Annual Meeting in January.

Treasurer's Report: Motion to accept the Treasurer's Report for October 2025 made by Alice, seconded by Margaret. Motion carries.

Highlights:

• Due to the death of an heir and a recalculation by C&N our Bixby distribution was significantly larger than in past years. At last month's meeting we decided to

- use \$16,000 of the distribution as Operating Income and the remaining \$34,085 as savings for future capital projects.
- We have done a great job containing expenses right on budget. Also, with the exception of pledge income, we are ahead of every income category for the past two years. We may very well end the year with a surplus.

Senior Warden's Report:

- We had a good turnout for the fall clean-up.
- The Youth Group attended a Corn Maze at Miller's Farm in Columbia Crossroads. It was a delightful excursion and included having smores and a band was present.
- Our time slot for The Bridge's Sleep-out is 4-5:00 pm on Friday, November 28th.
- We are looking to have a joint youth group with youth from Trula Hollywood's members. Also, a trip to New York City is in the planning stages.

Junior Warden/Building & Grounds Chair Report:

- Community Supper continues to thrive.
- Request to refinish the exterior doors: This would have to be an "off-site" project the doors would need to be removed and will need to be a summertime project.
- St. Mary's Guild Fall Fair efforts in progress.
- The under-cabinet light and an outlet in the Sacristy are not working. Will pass on to Jeff Watson to investigate. *The issue is resolved (thank you Jerry). The problem was a tripped breaker #8 in the Carillion hallway.*

Rector's Report:

- I have presided over two funerals.
- I held a training session for members of the Altar Guild.
- The Diocesan Convention was attended by Margaret and myself (Pastor Melinda).
- I used \$92.00 from the Discretionary Fund to put somebody up for one night.
- A check was sent to The Bridge for the 2nd and 3rd quarters totaling \$1,509.88.
- A Christmas and Pledge Letter will be sent to the membership in the near future.
- A Book Study is in progress.
- Due to Pastor Melinda attending a meeting in Lancaster December 8-10th the December Vestry meeting is to be rescheduled to Thursday, December 4, 2025.
- A Community Thanksgiving Worship will be held Wednesday, November 26 at St. John Lutheran Church.
