


**ANNOUNCES A BRIDGE REHABILITATION PROJECT TO BEGIN IN ATHENS TOWNSHIP.**

**PROJECT OVERVIEW:** This is a bridge rehabilitation project of the bridge that carries Wilawana Road (Route 4022) over the Chemung River. Additional work includes the resurfacing of Wilawana Road between Elmira Street (Route 1069) and Meadowlark Drive and the construction of a closed-circuit television (CCTV) camera at the US 220/Wilawana Road interchange.

**TRAFFIC IMPACT:** Traffic will be controlled using a combination of single lane restriction with flagging and lane shifts for resurfacing and CCTV installation and an anticipated directional detour, which will be in place while work on the bridge rehabilitation is completed. Construction is anticipated to begin spring 2026 and end fall 2027.


